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4. Student Accolades: P1 Students' Participation in Singapore Youth Festival (SYF): Young Artist's Talk

The Singapore Youth Festival (SYF) was conceived in 1966 in post-independence Singapore and officially launched by President Yusof Ishak in 1967.

Since then, the SYF has grown and evolved. Today, it marks a distinct and established season in our national school calendar, bringing together more than 36,000 students annually to share their artistic talents across its three platforms-the Arts Presentation, Art Exhibition and Celebrations.

The SYF Art Exhibition provides opportunities for students to showcase their artistic talents and promotes art appreciation in our schools. Alternating between primary schools and secondary schools/pre-universities every year, the exhibition underscores the role of arts education in nurturing our students to express themselves confidently and to find their voice.

Commemorating Singapore's 60th birthday in 2025, the theme for this year's SYF Art Exhibition- "*Artist and Collaboration: Tiny Wonders, Big Ideas*"- pays homage to our nation's journey. With their

artworks, students share fresh perspectives on everyday moments in Singapore and imagine what our shared future could look like.
