<p>3.</p>	<p><u>P6: SwimSafer 2.0 Programme</u></p> <p>Swimming is one of the key learning areas in the Physical Education (PE) syllabus and all primary schools leverage on the SwimSafer programme by SportSG to equip students with basic swimming and water survival skills before they graduate from primary school. Through the programme, students will learn essential swimming strokes, water entry/exit techniques, and basic floatation skills. They will also develop water safety awareness to prevent accidents in and around the pool.</p> <p>As the programme was suspended for a large part of 2020 due to COVID, schools are still in the process of bridging the learning for the different cohorts. For FGPS this year, all P6 students will participate in the programme as part of the 2025 post-PSLE activities. We will furnish more details regarding the P6 Swimsafer 2.0 programme to all P6 parents via a separate Parents Gateway (PG) notification that will be sent on 6 August 2025 (Wednesday).</p> <p>We have also made plans for our current P4 and P5 students to undergo the programme in 2026 and 2027 respectively, as part of their post-PSLE activities. 

Entries may be submitted individually or in groups of up to 6 members, under these categories:

- Primary Category: Open to primary school students
- Open Category: Open to secondary school students and above (no age limit)

The competition closes on **9 August 2025 (Saturday)**. Attractive prizes await the top three winners in each category, to be presented by Tanjong Pagar GRC Grassroots Advisers at the award ceremony. The school with the highest number of winning entries will also receive a prize. The award ceremony will be held on 8 November 2025 (Saturday), with further details to be shared in due course.
