3. Recess Art Jamming – Creating a Thaumatrope Toy!

We are excited to announce that our FGPS Art Department is organizing Recess Art Jamming, a fun and creative activity for our students during recess on 1 and 2 September 2025 (Monday and Tuesday) at the Sheltered Basketball Court (SBC)! The event aims to create an artistic platform for students to express their creativity through drawing and art-making in a spontaneous and joyful environment.

This year, students will get the opportunity to make their own thaumatrope, a simple toy from the 19th century. It has a picture on each side of a card, and when the card spins quickly, the two pictures look like they join together into one image. For example, a drawing of a bird on one side and a cage on the other will appear as a bird inside the cage when spun. This toy is one of the earliest steps towards animation.

This hands-on art experience nurtures our students as Joyful Learners and Resilient Innovators, in line with our school vision. While creating their thaumatrope toys, students will:

- Think Creatively experimenting with designs and ideas.
- **Show Resilience** refining their work through trial and error.
