We are pleased to share that the overwhelming majority of you found our current communication channels helpful and informative. Your thoughtful responses and constructive suggestions have provided us with invaluable insights into how we can continue to serve you and your children better.</p> <p>The feedback highlighted that whilst many of you appreciate the detailed weekly notifications, some have expressed that the frequency and volume of information can sometimes feel overwhelming. We have listened carefully to these concerns and recognise the importance of striking the right balance between keeping you well-informed and respecting your time.</p> <p><b>2) Supporting Our Teachers, Supporting Your Children</b></p> <p>Recent national studies, including the OECD Teaching and Learning International Survey, have shed light on the demanding nature of teaching in Singapore. Our teachers work tirelessly not just in the classroom, but also in planning engaging lessons, providing pastoral care, organising enriching activities, and maintaining meaningful communication with families like yours.
